Thank you for your interest in tennis tryouts.

Tennis tryouts will be held the last week of March after school... March 29, 30 and 31.

Tryouts will end at 5:15PM. Parents can pick up your athlete at the tennis courts or register to have them ride the late bus that drops off at Oak Ridge Elementary or Kaufman Elementary. Students MUST have a late bus pass to ride the bus.

Qualifications to Tryout:

- 1. Physical on file (copy of physical form is on the Irons Athletics website)
- 2. Complete Rank One online (link is on the Irons Athletics website)
- 3. Must be academically eligible (70 or higher in all classes)
- 4. If you require transportation a parent must sign up on the Conroe ISD Transportation website
- 5. Sign up with Coach Scurto at Room 135

Players that make the team will have the last 3 digits of their student ID posted outside room 135 on Friday April 1.

Athletes must wear tennis shoes and athletic clothing to try out. Shorts with pockets are encouraged. Athletes are encouraged to have their own tennis racquet, however, a racquet can be loaned to students during tryouts.

A \$75 spirit fee is required (checks payable to Irons Tennis Booster Club). Athletes will get a match tennis shirt and a can of tennis balls after paying the spirit fee. The spirit fee also supports the tennis program at Irons JH.

Game day tennis matches are 1 set, no ad first to 6 games. Everyone will play either doubles or singles. Matches are set up by skill level. Matches are typically played at high school tennis courts or at Blythe Calfee Tennis Center in Willis. Matches will start promptly at 4PM and continue until all matches are complete. Coach Scurto will drive athletes by bus to the match location. Athletes will be signed out by a parent/guardian from the match site to go home. No athletes will ride the bus back to Irons JH.
